Registration and Fees

Fees for the year are:

\$65 for Year 5 & 6 players

Fees are payable to the school at the beginning of the season into the school account online **12-3268-0086793-00** or via the school office. If paying online, please include references **Netball and Child's name**. Your fee covers the Cambridge Netball Centre fee per player/team and enables the school to supply uniform, further equipment for the season, training courses for upskilling our coaches and umpires, koha to junior umpires, certificates, medals (Year 6) and trophies for prize-giving.
